CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Playing colours other than maroon and white are permitted for Club Championships, as long as all team members are in identical clothing.

Club Championship events will start at 9:00am. Play will consist of a minimum of 3 rounds per day for all team events – Pairs, Triples and Fours. Singles will play a minimum of 4 rounds per day. The Bowls Operations Committee (BOC) reserves the right to alter these conditions without further notice.

1. The BOC is in charge of all competitions. Entries for all competitions will close at 6:00pm on the day prior to commencement of the competition. In the event the number of entries in drawn competition is insufficient to run the event, the BOC may accept late entries. The draw will be made at 6:15pm pm on the day prior to competition and those teams affected by any byes that apply in the first round will be notified. Players will be accepted in order of entry. All members entered in competitions are requested to be present, and entry fees paid, by 8:30am.
2. The BOC reserves the right to alter the number of ends in inclement weather
3. In the event that a player or team is not in a position to commence play within 10 minutes of the scheduled start time, the game shall be awarded to their opponent(s) unless otherwise specified by the BOC; alternatively, the opponent(s) may agree to play the game and it can be completed within any playing schedule laid down by the BOC
4. If a player(s) put their name on the board for a competition or championship and fail to notify the BOC that they are unable to play, or fail to appear for play after the draw has been completed, then the player(s) may be charged the prescribed entry fee for such competition
5. Members wishing to enter competitions or championships are required to enter their names on the whiteboards outside the BOC office. If the competition is postponed, then they must re-enter their name
6. All disputes are to be settled immediately by the BOC. Play is to be suspended until a decision is reached

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Games are no time limit. These conditions apply to both Men's and Women's Championships.

Singles	21 shots, 4 bowls per player
Pairs	18 ends, 3 bowls per player
Triples	18 ends, 2 bowls per player
Fours	15 ends, 2 bowls per player

These conditions are to mirror any alterations made by Auckland Bowls for Champion of Champion events

SUBSTITUTES AND REPLACEMENTS

All competitions and championships will be played under the Rules of Bowls New Zealand (Inc.)

The controversial rule that has caused concern is 'Club Championships will not be postponed in the event of members being selected for representative play'.

In Club or Centre competitions and tournaments, any substitute or replacement approved by the Controlling Body shall be a player who is a full member of the same club and/or WHERE POSSIBLE has not been a participant in the competition or tournament; and where practicable, is of equal or lesser playing ability to the player they are replacing or substituting.

The BOC asks that this rule be observed and that players and teams make every endeavour to find a substitute or replacement that has not previously played in the event. Where possible, the BOC will assist.

SATURDAY OR SUNDAY CLUB DAYS

These will take place during the summer with play commencing at 10:00am. Mufti can be worn at all of these events. These events will be single entry with teams drawn on the day. No pre-Arranged teams will be accepted. Club members are asked to have their names on the whiteboards outside the BOC office by 9:00am on the day of each event.

SATURDAY INTERCLUB – MEN AND WOMEN

This will be played over the following Saturdays in 2009. Please note there are No Reserve Days allocated for Interclub this season.

14 November

NATIONAL INTERCLUB 7's – MEN AND WOMEN

This event will be played over the weekend 28/29 November 2009. The team will consist of Singles, Pairs and Fours.

AUCKLAND 1-5 YEAR INTERCLUB 6's

This event will be played over the weekend 28/29 November 2009. The team will consist of Singles, Pairs and Triples. Teams may be any combination.

FRIDAY OPTIONAL INTERCLUB

This competition commences 12 February 2010. Teams will consist of 3 Triples. Teams may be any combination.

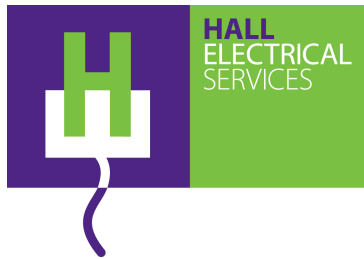
Correct bowling attire must be worn at all times when playing in the following events:
